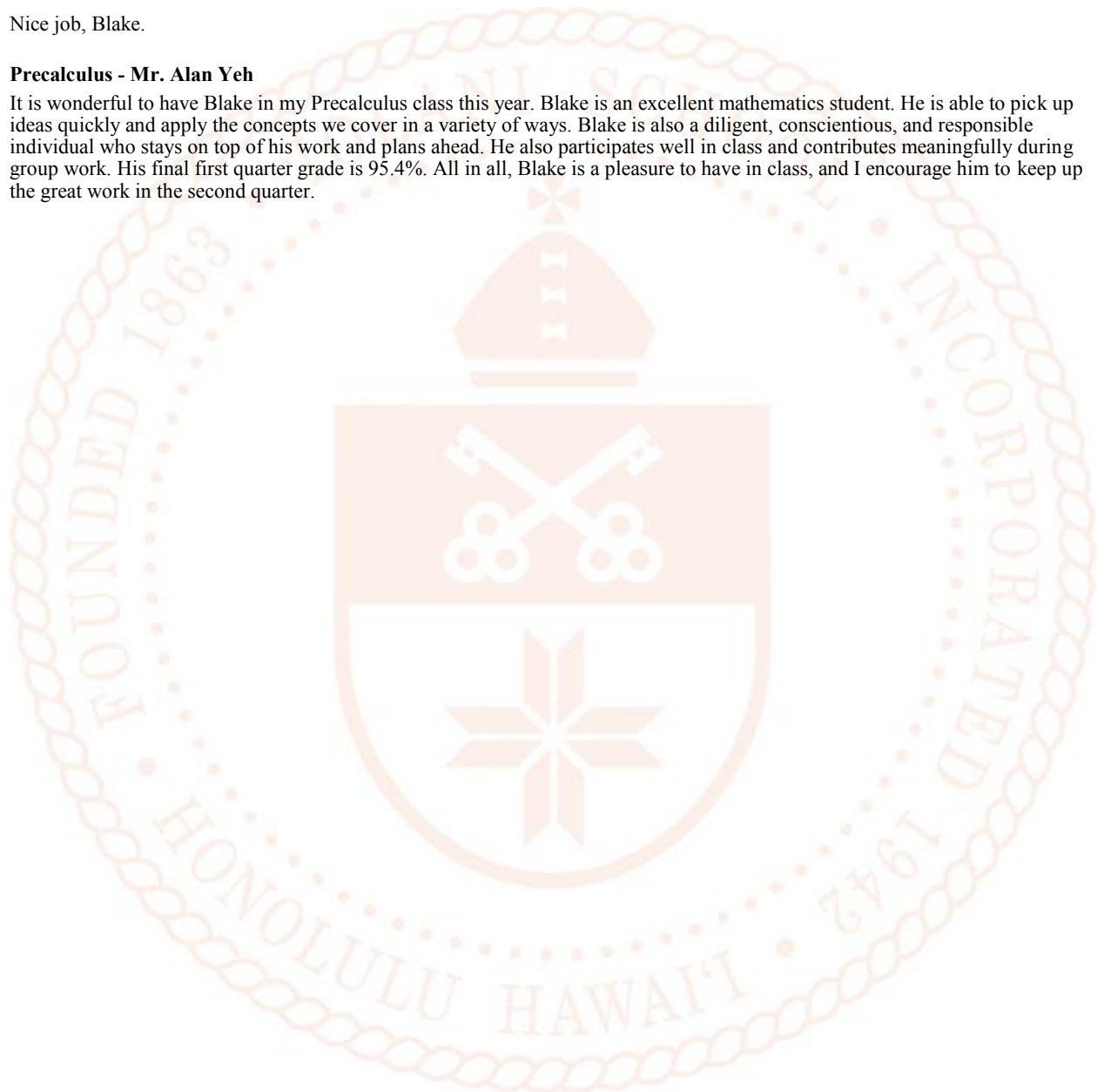

To conclude the semester, students submitted a final portfolio of their best work in lieu of a final exam.
